CBA Highlight –Late Breaks 14.08 (c) *If an employee is not provided with a break (either a lunch break or rest period) within two hours and forty-five minutes of the end of the employee's previous break or commencement of the employee's shift, the employee will have the option of either: (a) receiving*

compensation for twenty minutes of time at regular wages or, (b) leaving their scheduled shift twenty (20) minutes early (operations permitting). It is understood that even in the event one of the above options is implemented due to a late break, the employee is entitled to have a rest period as soon as possible. Employees must remain on site during all breaks and respond to any emergencies that occur.
