We are happy to report we have been working hard and have implemented a number of the items already:

- A full grievance report is available on our website.

 - English and French printed copies are being produced and mailed to every member's home address.
- Quarterly meetings of all Unit Chairpersons have been arranged and scheduled for the next 12 months.
- The union representatives' job descriptions have been developed and are now on the website.
- Quarterly membership meetings via Zoom have been scheduled for 2021.
- The union has negotiated with the employer that new members will get a short meet-and-greet with the local union representative.
 - An orientation package is being put together for distribution. It should be ready early in the new year.
- The latest Senior Advisory Committee (SAC) report is posted on the website, detailing the issues the union is raising with the employer.

There are more action items we are working on. Check the website often to see our progress.
